Members of the Regional Service Team were present to answer any questions we may have.

Discussed having a Weekend while not having a complete Secretariat or School of Leaders – Members of the Regional Service team responded with their thoughts on the matter.

Having an active SOL is more important than a complete Secretariat. The alternative might be a group of dedicated Cursillistas that spend time together in group reunion and some kind of formation in preparation for the Weekend while trying to develop a SOL. People who will be serving on teams should be involved with SOL although this isn't always the case. Need people who know the Method and Mentality to be presenting at SOL. Being spread out makes meeting in person difficult so using a service like Zoom is a good alternative. Hardest part is getting people interested. Secretary Report – Teri Gabor – Teri emailed the Secretariat minutes from the February 28, 2022 meeting to all members. No corrections needed to be made.

Treasurer Report – Baron Johnson – Sent out the checking account info for March and April. March had a lot of expenses for the Regional Spring Encounter. Spent \$1014.80 for food and paper products. \$128.00 left over to be used for the Men's weekend. All the food was put out and Regional Team responded with a check quickly. Will reach out to the candidates about what to bring and what to expect. Will check with Jim Connors on the appropriate list of things to bring.

Cursillo – Jim Connors – See Report. Women's weekend is scheduled for October 27-31, 2022. Last from Vicki was that we had 15 applications turned in. We do not have a Rectora or a list of possible candidates for Rectora. Put together a list of Ultreya attendance at OLOF and St. Mary's. Don't have one for St. Jude. Men's weekend is May 19-22, 2022. Lost two team members. Juggled some of the men and still need to find someone to be a Shepherd and give the Ideal Rollo. Reformation meetings will be April 30 and May 14 at OLOF. Hoping all team members can attend at least one. Need a priest for Saturday night and Sunday. Deacon Bill said he will take care of finding priests. Deacon Brian Gabor has agreed to help out also. Not supplying soft drinks anymore. Had reserved 4 weekends at the Retreat Center, dropped two and keeping the weekends of April 27-30 and Nov 2-5. Covid requirements have been completely dropped.
