What an awesome weekend was presented to us at the Regional Encounter at Our Lady of the Snows in Bellville I llinois. Our arrival brought the renewal of meetings among friends from 15 different dioceses in Kentucky, Arkansas, Ohio, I ndiana, I llinois, Missouri and friends from across the state of Tennessee. This bond of friendship between Cursillistas always brings joy to my heart. We are fellow pilgrims on a journey to the same destination of our life in Christ. And this year we walked that journey to Jesus Christ with Mary, Our

Mother. Her summons to us was accompanied by one of our favorite songs: "The Summons" by John L. Bell. The tune is by Kelvingrove.

Each talk during the weekend was centered on Mary and included one of the verses of this song: 1. Mother of Beautiful Love, 2. Thy Will Be Done, 3. Cause of Our Joy, and 4. Queen of Peace. And how could they not call out to us to live our life with Mary for Christ like is set forth in these verses. Will you come and follow me if I but call your name?

First *Piety* – Her unequivocal "Yes" to the angel when the angel appeared to her and said, "Hail, favored one! The Lord is with you." In Luke 1:38, "Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Mary put her complete love and trust in God. Next we have *Study*. Mary did this as we read in Luke 1:29,

"But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be." She studied this in her heart. And last *Action*. Mary immediately went to visit Elizabeth when she heard her good news. We read in Luke 1:41-43, "When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, "Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb."

This has been the fourth Regional Encounter that I have attended, including the one we hosted in 2005. As I become the Pre-Cursillo representative and hand off my duties as Palanca Coordinator and Editor of the Rooster Crows, I leave you with this thought and ask you to continue to say Yes. You have said yes many times already with your support for the Palanca/Prayer Vigil for our local weekends. When I first started working on this, it was difficult to fill all the hours on the weekend. But you have said YES and have offered real palanca. I encourage you to continue to offer Palanca for the Cursillo movement both here in our diocese and around the world. Listen to the call you receive from the Holy Spirit and from Our Lady. And like Mary give a resounding YES!
