#### Elections, elections, elections; County, State, National and our own Cursillo Secretariat elections are all approaching fast.

Please consider

one of these vacancies and enter your name on the ballot. These positions on the Secretariat are being vacated this year: Lay Director, (the nominee must have served on a Secretariat on be serving on a Secretariat) the Pre-Cursillo Representative, the English Coordinator, the Spanish Coordinator of the Three Days, and the Co-coordinator of the Spanish School of Leaders. We are also still looking for someone with some computer skills to take over the Rooster Crows Editor's position.

The Lay Director holds office for a term of three years and is limited to two terms of office. That individual interacts with the Regional and National Secretariats to

ensure proper procedure and commitment to the movement is primary. He or she must lead by example and reports to the Bishop on an annual basis.

Secretariat Elections

The Pre-Cursillo Representative serves for three years and is not limited (at present) to the number of terms served. This person is responsible for the selection and preparation of all candidates who will live a Cursillo in the Diocese. He or she receives applications and notifies candidates and sponsors of their acceptance for a weekend.

The Coordinator of the Cursillo Weekend (English or Spanish) serves for three years and is not limited (at present) to the number of terms served. This person ensures that all the necessary elements for the Cursillo Weekend are available. This includes such things as team selection

(approved by the Secre-

### tariat), team preparation, overseeing of the facilities, comfort (proper nourishment and rest) and necessary supplies.

Each candidate must submit in writing their intention to run for a particular position by snail mail or email to the Lay Director at least seven days prior to the election on September 25th. Each current Secretariat area will have one vote for each position. The votes will be by secret ballot and be counted by Fr. Alex.

The Editor of the Rooster Crows is not an elected position and serves by appointment of the 4th Day Coordinator. The articles are usually submitted by Secretariat members.
