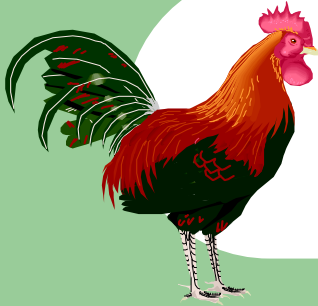

God placed you in a unique environment. It is within that environment that you are called to spread the Faith. Have you or could you do better? Most of us will answer

yes to both. Ask yourself the following questions:

- Have you made a continuous effort to make friends
- Are all your friend-efforts with those just like you, or have you stepped out of your comfort zone in making friends— such as age, profession, race...?
- Have you shared your faith and Cursillo with your friends?
- Have you invited friends to a Group Reunions or Ultreyas?
- Have you looked for leaders and sought out their candidacy for Cursillo?
- Have you made a conscious effort to seek and encourage potential leaders to make a Cursillo movement?

To help you accomplish these things, you have a great resource at your disposal – your Parish Cursillo Representative. Your Parish Representative is your initial go-to resource regarding all things dealing with Cursillo. Make use of

her/him! He/she educates parishioners about Cursillo, has information about groups and Weekends, has literature, and has application forms for your candidates.
